Air-Edel Records will release Patrick Neil Doyle's score for historical feature documentary '**Nae Pasaran**' on 27<sup>th</sup> August 2018 across all major digital platforms including iTunes, Amazon and Spotify.

'**Nae Pasaran**' tells the story of the Rolls-Royce factory workers in Scotland who refused to carry out vital repairs to the Hawker Hunter jet engines used by General Pinochet, and ultimately saved thousands of lives in Chile during the 1970s. It received its premiere as the closing film at the Glasgow Film Festival in March, and will be released in cinemas on September 11<sup>th</sup> 2018.

The documentary is filled with immense determination, loss, discovery, triumph, and sincerely touching moments that continually moved and inspired me. **ABOUT THE COMPOSER:**

Patrick is a classically trained film and television composer, who has composed scores for feature films such as 'The Legend of Longwood' and 'Kepler's Dream', and for television drama series including King Bert Productions' 'The Moonstone' for BBC1.

In the world of feature film, Patrick has also composed additional music and lyrics for international feature films such as 'Brave' (Disney Pixar), 'Sleuth' (Castle Rock Entertainment), 'La Ligne Droite' (Gaumont), and the documentary feature 'Jig', directed by Sue Bourne. In 2016, Patrick worked as music programmer on the remake of 'Whisky Galore', Amma Asante's feature film 'A United Kingdom', starring Rosamund Pike and David Oyelowo, and on the Sony Animation 'The Emoji Movie'.

His work for theatre includes William Boyd's sell out run of 'Longing' at the Hampstead Theatre, and the Edinburgh Fringe 2012 revival of the 1977 musical 'Glasvegas'. Patrick also worked on the critically acclaimed Manchester International Festival production of 'Macbeth', directed by Kenneth Branagh and Rob Ashford. More recently Patrick worked as musical director and music programmer for Branagh's season at the Garrick Theatre.
